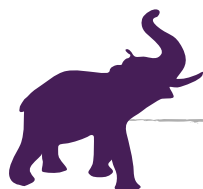


EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The JEH Foundation for Pancreatic Cancer (“JEH Foundation”) encourages all young people to continue their education. We want to help eligible high school and college students who have been financially affected by Pancreatic Cancer. The primary purpose of the JEH Foundation is to provide financial assistance for deserving high school and college students that have been impacted by pancreatic cancer. The awarded scholar must have goals for further education and selection will be based on financial need and educational merit.

The scholarship will be awarded based on the decision of a panel put together by the JEH Foundation. The application deadline is **March 31, 2017** and the scholarship will be funded by **July 31, 2017**. The scholarship is a to be determined amount depending on how much the JEH Foundation is able to raise for the 2016 calendar year.

The JEH Foundation is a 501c3 non-profit foundation. The JEH Foundation has defined itself by helping families suffering from pancreatic cancer, mainly in the way of educational scholarships. Joe Hasten inspired his family to launch the JEH Foundation. On June 1, 2011 Joe was diagnosed with stage IV pancreatic cancer. Sadly, Joe lost his life on November 1, 2011. Joe was asymptomatic at the time of diagnoses. His disease was discovered in routine blood tests. Joe influenced many people throughout his life. He preached the importance and value of education in achieving goals and dreams.

The application has three parts: (1) personal and academic information, (2) essay, and (3) attachments including one written academic reference. All parts must be completed and submitted by the deadline listed above in order to be considered for the scholarship.
